Poster	The impact of COVID-19 within stage migration and upstage diagnostic in multiple cancer lineages	Society of Surgical Oncology	Cancers with established early screening measures made patients present at an earlier age when receiving treatment in the COVID era.
Poster	Neoadjuvant Chemotherapy and 90-Day Survival in Patients with Stage 2 Stomach Cancer	Society for Surgery of the Alimentary Tract	Adjuvant chemotherapy showed improved 90-day survival
Paper	Examining the Effect of Intramuscular vs Intravenous Metoclopramide for Treatment of Acute Headaches to Expedite Throughput in the Emergency Department	Journal of Emergency Medicine	Found that intramuscular metoclopramide may substantially improve ED throughput times as measured by time from physician evaluation for the treatment of migraine headaches when compared to intravenous administration, with no apparent differences in pain reduction.
Paper	Retrospective Analysis of Diuretic Regimens and Readmission Rates in Patients with Acute Decompensated Heart Failure	American Heart Association	After controlling for demographic factors, albumin levels, and comorbidities, the diuretic drug regimens patients were prescribed for CHF significantly predicted readmission at 30 days and one year.
Poster	Predicting CAMH Follow-up Visit Needs in a Large Community Mental Health Clinic.	American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry	Adolescents were less likely to come to follow up visits relative to children for mental health care
Poster	Marijuana and its Relationship with Duration of Nausea/Vomiting in Pregnancy	American Society of Addiction Medicine	Though patients often report MJ use for management of NV in pregnancy, MJ use was associated with higher likelihood of acute care utilization without reduction in duration of symptoms or in antiemetic prescriptions.

Paper	Associations Between Cannabis Use in Pregnancy and Severity and Duration of Nausea/Vomiting, and Anti Emetic Prescriptions	American Journal of Drug and Alcohol Abuse	Our study demonstrates that previously identified patient reported barriers to obtaining evidence-based medications for nausea/vomiting in pregnancy may be valid.
Paper	Anxiety and depressive symptoms in patients with COPD: Modifiable explanatory factors.	Western Journal of Nursing Research	A large scale retrospective analysis determined that anxiety and depressive symptoms present in individuals with can be independently be predicted by a number of modifiable behavioral and somatic factors, including the self-care ability of the person to manage their disease.
Paper	Cardiovascular disease as a moderator between GOLD stage severity and quality of life in COPD patients.	Journal of Cardiovascular Nursing	A large scale secondary data analysis that identified the differential impact of cardiovascular comorbidity on quality of life at each stage of airflow limitation present among individuals living with COPD. At later stages of COPD, cardiovascular disease became less relevant to a person's quality of life.
Paper	Association of type of vaccination center with time to emergency department presentation for acute COVID-19 infection: An exploratory analysis.	Cureus	Found that location of COVID-19 vaccine reception geographically may play a significant role in the time to presentation to the ED for acute COVID-19 infection, which brought to light questions regarding the supply chain and ultracool storage requirements of the vaccine during a global pandemic
Podium	Pneumothorax was more common in covid-positive patients during the delta surge and remains prognostic for very poor outcomes: A retrospective cohort study.	American College of Surgeons Clinical Congress	Pneumothorax was found to occur at substantially greater rates during the delta surge of the COVID-19 pandemic when compared to other periods of the pandemic and signaled poor prognostic outcomes.

Poster	Symptom cluster characterization upon inpatient admission in those with independent or comorbid Heart Failure and Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease	American Thoracic Society	Found three distinct symptom clusters were present at time of admission for acute exacerbation of either COPD, HF, or concomitant disease.
Poster	Effect of COVID-19 on spontaneous pneumothorax incidence.	American Thoracic Society	Demonstrated a substantial effect of COVID-19 on the incidence of spontaneous pneumothorax during the COVID-19 pandemic
Poster	Symptom clusters at time of exacerbation predict 90-day readmissions among individuals living with Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease or Heart Failure	Southern Nursing Research Society	Identified multiple symptoms clusters are distinct and present at the time of exacerbation for diseases of COPD, Heart Failure, or concomitant disease, and there is a significant association with experiencing these clusters and 90-readmission rates.
Poster	Where Have We Lost Them? The Unheard Narratives of Geriatric Mental Health	Florida Psychiatric Society	Highlighted the needs of geriatric persons receiving care at LRH in that these individuals were likely to have less reported follow up visits than adult patients.

Poster	Child and Adolescent Mental Health Follow Up Visits in a Traditional Outpatient Clinic: Evidence for Bringing the Village to the Adolescent	American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry - in progress	Found that there are distinct differences in the number of follow up visits attended between adolescent and adult patients, but not children and adult patients, related to mental health services.
